

Mayor David Sims called the special council meeting of May 26, 2016 to order at 11:32 a.m. Present for the meeting were Mayor Sims, Council President Rick Alonzo, Council Members Ron Smith and Connie Wells, Clerk Kris Larson, City Administrator Mike Klaus, and Attorney Andrakay Pluid. Councilman Adam Arthur was gone on personal business.

The purpose of the special meeting was to award the bid for the Augusta Street Sidewalk and Drainage project.

Mike Klaus said we received three bids for the project with the lowest bid being from KG&T Septic. He recommended award to KG&T Septic contingent on the State's approval of the bid. There was a \$3.17 difference between KG&T's total and Eric Olson's recap. Mike's figure includes the correction, as it was a math error. He said the bid is close to the amount estimated for the project. Alternate A is for sewer line replacement on Augusta Street.

The project is estimated to begin somewhere between mid-June and the third week in June. Mike said the Notice to Proceed starts the clock ticking. He said the part of Augusta Street north of Lincoln Street has to be completed first.

Connie Wells moved to award the bid to KG&T Septic for the Augusta Street Project for the base bid of \$343,732.38 plus \$86,387.58 for alternate A contingent on the State's approval. Rick Alonzo seconded the motion. The motion passed – Ron Smith “yes”, Rick Alonzo “yes”, Connie Wells “yes”.

The meeting adjourned at 11:41 a.m.
